Upon entering in Miss Kalgoorlie, a full payment of \$200 or a deposit of \$100.00 is required within 2 weeks from your entered date.

If a deposit is paid then the remaining balance of \$100.00 is to be paid within 6 weeks of the entrant's application being accepted or by 2 weeks prior to the competition's commencement date, whichever comes first. Failure to do so within the provided time frame will result in disqualification from the competition.

ALL fees paid to Mini Miss Pageants Australia are non-refundable and Non-Transferable.

FORMAL

This round is where each contestant will participate in a formal runway show.

Judging criteria:

Outfit/ Overall look | 10

Walk/ Model style | 10

Personality/ Confidence | 10

Each contestant will be asked to provide their own hair and makeup as well as age appropriate Formal Wear outfit.

Female contestants are required to wear a formal gown that is ankle length or longer as well as wear suitable high heeled shoes (or dress shoes for junior or little contestants) that are appropriate for runway walking. Mr contestants are required to wear a formal suit with dress shoes.

CASUAL

This round is where each contestant will walk in a Casual themed runway.

Judging criteria:

Outfit/ Overall look | 10

Walk/ Model style |10

Personality/ Confidence |10

Each contestant will be asked to provide their own hair and makeup as well as age-appropriate Casual outfit. All contestants must wear a form of footwear.



FASHION

This round is where each contestant will walk in a Fashioned themed runway show.

Judging criteria:

Outfit/ Overall look | 10

Walk/ Model style |10

Personality/ Confidence |10

Each contestant will be asked to provide their own hair and makeup as well as age-appropriate Fashion outfit. All contestants must wear a form of footwear.

OPENING NUMBER

This is only required for our JUNIOR, TEEN, MISS & MS contestants.

What is Required:

- Each contestant will do a introductory group walk down the runway (follow the leader style)
- Each contestant will then perform a quick solo walk as our announcer introduces them as a contestant in the competition.
- Once your solo walk is complete you can go and get changed into your Formal Wear

*Our LITTLE & MR contestants will be ready in their Formal wear to begin the competition as soon as the Opening number ends.

ECO (OPTIONAL EXTRA \$20.00)

Entered contestants will get the chance to show us their unique style by hand making a completely eco-friendly outfit.

Judging Criteria

Outfit/ Overall look |20

Walk/ Model style |5

Personality/ Confidence |5

Each contestant will be asked to provide their own hair and makeup as well as age-appropriate outfit.

Rules :

- All products used must be listed and handed in by June 13th
- Parents help is allowed

PHOTOGENIC (OPTIONAL EXTRA \$20.00)

Entered contestants are required to participate in an individual photoshoot on June 13th with a professional photographer. The aim will be to take the perfect photo. The contestants will only have 15 frames to take the perfect shot.

Final Image | 10

All photos will be taken against a plain background. Contestants are required to wear a white top and jeans. All final shots will be provided to contestants as a part of the free professional photos.

Teen Miss Kalgoorlie

This round is where each contestant will take a 3 min standing interview with each judge individually. There are no set questions. This is a 3 min conversation on the following topics.

Hobbies

Ambitions & goals in life

Achievements

Contestants will be scored between 0-30 points for this division.

20 points for conversation and delivery

10 points for appearance/ clothing attire.

You are required to come with a natural hair and makeup look to the interview round; dressed in an appropriate interview outfit.



MISS & MS

This round is where each contestant will take a 3 min standing interview with each judge individually. There are no set questions. This is a 3 min conversation on the following topics.

Your future goals in your career or life

Ambitions & Hobbies

Achievements & What you have overcome

Why do you think you would make a good representative for Miss Kalgoorlie

Contestants will be scored between 0-30 points for this division.

20 points for conversation and delivery

10 points for appearance/ clothing attire.

You are required to come with a natural hair and makeup look to the interview round; dressed in an appropriate interview outfit.

(FREE OPTIONAL EXTRA)

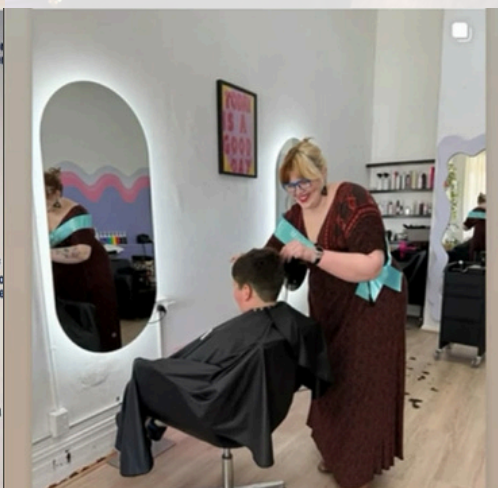

In **every age division** a Queen, a Princess and Duchess's will be crowned.

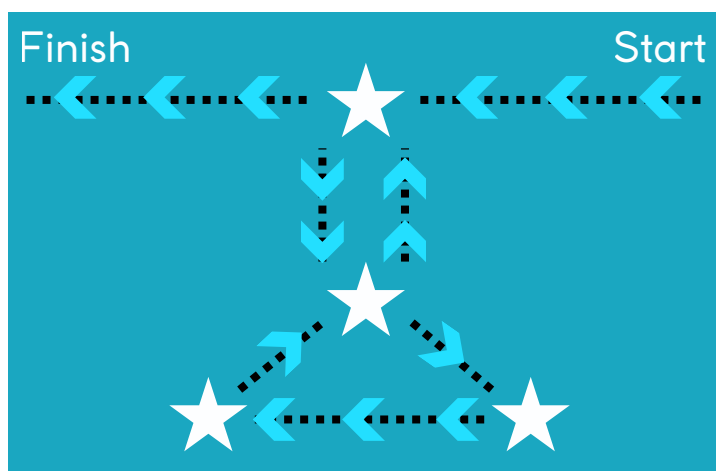

STAGE DIRECTIONS

Walk the runway by following the areas and posing at each star every time you land on one. There will be clearly laid out markings on the stage and assistance for the younger age groups. We will also have an open stage time in which contestants can freely practice on the stage.

Applicant attests that they are and will continue to be an individual of excellent moral disposition; they have not nor will not engage in any act incompatible with the highest of public ethical expectations and etiquette or that will reflect adversely on Mini Miss Pageants including, but not limited to, the Mini Miss Pageants Title or the Licensee or the Promoter or the Sponsors or any persons associated with Mini Miss Pageants; that they have not committed a criminal act or appeared in, or posed for, nude or provocative photos or videos prior to, during the competition finals or during their reign should they become the title holder of Mini Miss Pageants.
2. Applicant shall present themselves in a gracious, respectful manner at all times during any Mini Miss Pageants competition and while representing any Mini Miss Pageants Title.
3. Applicant will not make false accusations or derogative comments about other contestants, judges, employees, Director of Mini Miss Pageants or anyone else associated with Mini Miss Pageants. Defamatory verbal and/or written comments against Mini Miss Pageants will result in instantaneous disqualification, relinquishment of any and all prizes and awards won and legal action.
