Upon entering in Miss Tasmania, a full payment of \$300.00 or a deposit of \$200.00 is required within 2 weeks from your entered date.

If a deposit is paid then the remaining balance of either \$100.00 is to be paid within 6 weeks of the entrant's application being accepted or by 2 weeks prior to the competition's commencement date, whichever comes first. Failure to do so within the provided time frame will result in disqualification from the competition.

MISS TASMANIA 2025

OPENING

This is an unscored runway walk for all contestants. This is just a bit of fun and a way for the judges to get a glance at everyone before the competition. Each contestant will perform an opening number routine (learnt on Day 1) in a cocktail style outfit of their choice. To show support to our chosen charity "The Cancer Council" all opening outfits need to be any shade of yellow or have a base colouring of yellow.





FORMAL

This round is where each contestant will participate in a formal runway show.

Judging criteria:

Outfit/ Overall look | 10

Walk/ Model style |10

Personality/ Confidence |10



Each contestant will be asked to provide their own hair and makeup as well as age appropriate Formal Wear outfit. Female contestants are required to wear a formal gown that is ankle length or longer as well as wear suitable high heeled shoes (or dress shoes for junior, mini or little contestants) that are appropriate for runway walking. Master contestants are required to wear a formal suit with dress shoes.

CASUAL

This round is where each contestant will walk in a Casual themed runway.

Personality/ Confidence |10


Each contestant will be asked to provide their own hair and makeup as well as ageappropriate Casual outfit. All contestants must wear a form of footwear.



FASHION

This round is where each contestant will walk in

a Fun Fashioned themed runway show.

All contestants must wear a form of footwear.

Entered contestants are required to participate in an individual photoshoot on Saturday 8th of November with a professional photographer. The aim will be to take the perfect shot. The contestants will only have 15 frames to take the perfect shot.

Contestants will be scored between 0-30 points for this division.

20 points for conversation and delivery

10 points for appearance/ clothing attire.

You are required to come with a natural hair and makeup look to the interview round; dressed in an appropriate interview outfit.

Contestants are encouraged to post about their pageant journey on social media platforms such as Instagram and Facebook. At the awards ceremony we will award the title of Social Media Queen to the contestant that has represented themselves and Mini Miss Pageants appropriately using their creativity to promote our values of "Inspire, Creativity, Respect, Compassion & Positivity".

Once your deposit is paid you will be sent your contestant national sash to use.

AWARDS

Miss Tasmania will award a **top 5** which includes the overall winner for the **Miss Tasmania, Ms Tasmania, Teen Miss Tasmania, and Junior Miss Tasmania** contestants.

In every **age division** a Queen, a Princess and Duchess's will be crowned.


In the **Master and Little Miss Division** a 1st Place (Master Tasmania/ Little Miss Tasmania), 2nd Place (King/ Queen), 3rd Place (Prince/ Princess) and Duke's/ Duchess's will be crowned.

One of the following will be awarded:

Miss/ Mr Photogenic (Overall), Miss / Mr Charity Winner (Overall), Miss/ Mr Congeniality (Overall), Miss Interview (Overall), Social Media Queen (Overall) & Judges encouragement.

Per each **age division** we will also hand out the **top 4** for the following awards:

Evening wear | Fun Fashion | Causal Wear | Photogenic | Charity | Interview | Social Media



- ➤ The first 2 contestants will each go & stand on one of the TWO spots at the back of the stage (e.g., 1,2).
- When their individual name is called (once they hit spot 2) they will go & stand on spot 3.
- ▶ They will then perform their individual walk down the runway stopping at spot 4, returning to spot 3 & then continuing off the stage.
- When that contestant is performing their walk, then the remaining contestant will move across to spot 2 to allow for another contestant to stand on spot 1.
- Contestants will perform a group "snake" at the end of each category.

STAGE DIRECTIONS

- *A contestants individual time onstage should be between 40-50secs
- *Contestants are allowed to stay at spot 4, waking to both sides of the front of runway if they wish.

 - 2. Applicant shall present themselves in a gracious, respectful manner at all times during any Mini Miss Pageants competition and while representing any Mini Miss Pageants Title.
- 3. Applicant will not make false accusations or derogative comments about other contestants, judges, employees, Director of Mini Miss Pageants or anyone else associated with Mini Miss Pageants. Defamatory verbal and/or written comments against Mini Miss Pageants will result in instantaneous disqualification, relinquishment of any and all prizes and awards won and legal action.
 - 4. Applicant publicly posting defamatory comments on all media and public networking platform's will be immediately disqualified.
 - 5. Applicant must display a courteous, sportsmanship like manner at all times. Disorderly conduct prior to, during and after the competition may result in
